



# HOW TO CLEAN SPRAY TANK, FILTERS, AND ACCESSORIES BEFORE BIOLOGICAL USE

**Spray equipment will have to be free from harsh farm chemical residues (fungicides, herbicides and bactericides) or otherwise cleaned prior to use.**

## **To clean equipment**

1. Remove spray tank filters.
2. Soak filters for 3-4 hours in a concentrated Urea or Bicarbonate of soda solution (2kg of Urea or BC in 10L of water).
3. Dissolve 5 kg of Urea or BC in a 1000L spray tank.
4. Run the pump until all hoses and nozzles are filled with Urea or BC solution and let sit overnight.
5. The next day, empty the tank and flush the filters and spray tank prior to spraying.
6. Preferably spray biologicals in the late afternoon.
